 Look for Leo the Lion, Jupiter, and Venus



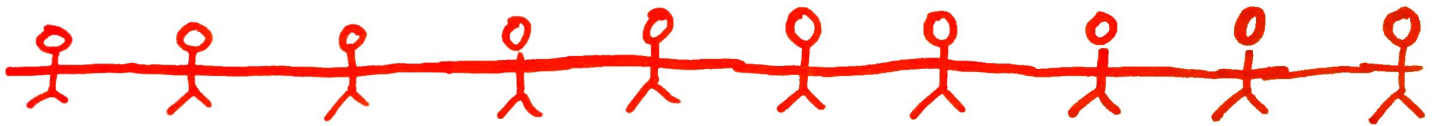




What can Jenny & Johnny do?

Magazine Craft:

Quilling

You need

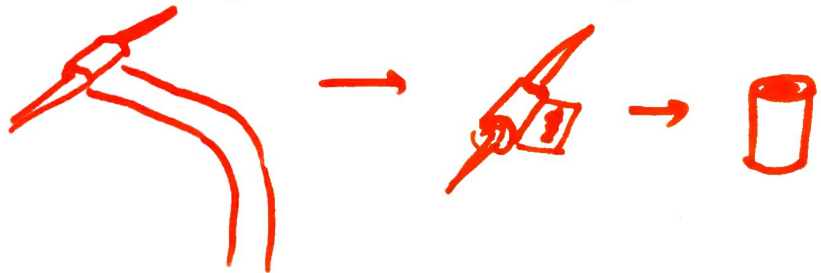
- magazines or scrap paper
- ruler
- pencil (optional)
- scissors
- glue or glue stick
- piece of cardboard or plain paper
- toothpick

- Use ruler to mark $\frac{1}{4}$ " (quarter inch) strips along a page of magazine or scrap paper (with pencil)



- cut the strips with scissors carefully

- Start rolling the strip onto a toothpick tightly - glue on the end



- OR start rolling, then slip off the toothpick and let the curl loosen. Then, glue in place



you can also pinch the ends to make shapes



- Connect multiple colored pieces with glue to make animals, flowers, whatever!



- glue them onto cardboard or paper to display and give.
